Petitioner Rakesh Kumar Talwar has filed this petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail in complaint case No.78/2016 dated 16.06.2016 titled as Bank of Baroda Vs. Rakesh Kumar and others, under Sections 406/420/468/120-B of the Indian Penal Code.

Notice of motion was issued.

Learned counsel for the respondent has appeared and contested this petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties and have gone through the record.

The petitioner has been summoned in a complaint case to face the trial. In compliance of order dated 27.03.2019, the petitioner has already surrendered before the trial Court and has been released on interim bail.

The petitioner is not required for any investigation or

interrogation purposes as he is only to face the trial. No useful purpose would be served by sending him to custody.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts of the case in minute details and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, I find merit in this petition and the same is allowed. The order dated 27.03.2019, granting interim bail to the petitioner, is made absolute.
