The present petition has been filed under Section 439 Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of regular bail to petitioner-Surinder, in case FIR No.201 dated 31.08.2017 registered for the offences punishable under Sections 498-A and 304-B of the Indian Penal Code at Police Station Kalayat, District Kaithal, Haryana.

Smt. Indu Bala had died few months after putting off her bridal bangles (suhag chura). She was married on 26.08.2016 and died on 31.08.2017 by way of hanging. The allegation has been levelled against the petitioner and his family members for demanding dowry and beating her with cruelty.

It has been argued by learned counsel for the petitioner that other relatives of the petitioner have been exonerated during investigation and case is of false nature. But to the mind of this court, serious allegations have been levelled against the petitioner and his wife had died in his house under unnatural circumstances.

No case is made out to grant concession of regular bail.
Petition stands dismissed accordingly.
