Present petition under Section 439 of the Criminal Procedure Code is for grant of regular bail to petitioner—Lakhwinder alias Lakhu in case F.I.R. No.118 dated 27.09.2018 under Sections 147, 148, 149, 323, 324, 341, 307 of the Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station GRP, Hisar.

As per last order dated 19.08.2019, statement of complainant-Nawab Singh has already been recorded before learned trial Court.

Learned counsel representing the petitioner mainly contended that the petitioner is in custody since 25.10.2018 and the trial of the case still to take some more time and no useful purpose would be served by detaining the petitioner behind the bars, so he be released on bail.

Learned State counsel opposed the prayer for bail on the ground that remaining main prosecution witnesses are yet to be examined.

At this stage, without commenting anything on the merits of the case, which may not cause prejudice to either of the parties at a later stage of the trial and taking into consideration the above facts and the fact that the petitioner is in custody since 25.10.2018; trial of the case still to take some more time and no useful purpose would be served by detaining the petitioner behind the bars, the present petition is allowed. Petitioner—Lakhwinder alias Lakhu, is ordered to be admitted to regular bail on his furnishing bail bond and surety bond to the satisfaction of concerned learned trial Judge/ Chief Judicial Magistrate/ Duty Magistrate.
