By this petition, filed under the provisions of Section 439 of the Cr.P.C., the petitioner seeks the concession of 'regular bail'.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the co-accused of the petitioner already having been admitted to bail by a coordinate Bench of this court on 18.09.2019, the petitioner cannot be denied the same parity.

Learned State counsel on instructions from the police official who is present in court to assist him and after examining the case file, does not deny that the petitioner was the one driving/riding the scooter, with the other accused sitting pillion and that the contraband is stated to have been recovered from a bag that is stated to have been fallen on the ground from the scooter.

That being so, this petition is allowed in the same terms as the

on 18.09.2019.
