RAJ SHEKHAR ATTRI, J. (ORAL):

The petitioners have preferred the instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., for grant of pre-arrest bail in case FIR No.152 dated 30.05.2018, registered under Sections 498-A IPC (Sections 354/506 and 406 IPC added later on) at Police Station City Sangrur.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the compromise between the parties has been effected and a petition under Section 13-B of the Hindu Marriage Act, has been filed before the trial Court. Learned counsel for the petitioners has placed on record a copy of the same and also a copy of the statements of the parties recorded by the trial Court.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from the Investigating Officer has stated that the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is no more required for custodial interrogation.

In the circumstances, without going into the merits of the case,

I do not deem it appropriate to deny the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in the present case. Ordered accordingly.

Resultantly, the interim order dated 26.06.2018 is made absolute subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands allowed.
