Petitioner-Rajesh Puri has filed this petition under Section 482 of Cr.P.C. for restraining the respondents from conducting multiple inquiries in the same matter which had already been inquired thrice by three different officials as matter had already been inquired as per the orders of DGP.

On 28.03.2019, the following order was passed:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that previously three enquiries were conducted wherein nothing was found worth against the petitioner on a complaint given by one Bahal Singh. The said reports are on record as Annexures P-5, P-7 and P-8.

Yet again a complaint has been filed by Bahal Singh whereupon an enquiry has been initiated afresh. Mr. H.S. Sitta, AAG, Punjab is directed to find out the status of the fresh complaint, (if any).

Adjourned to 29.04.2019.”

In compliance of the order dated 28.03.2019, status report by way of affidavit of Deep Kamal, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Kharar, District SAS Nagar (Mohali) on behalf of respondent Nos.1 to 3 has been filed in the Court today and the same is taken on record. Copy given to counsel opposite.

In the status report it is mentioned that on the basis of enquiry conducted by Superintendent of Police (Investigation) SAS Nagar, Mohali, a case FIR No.0105 dated 18.04.2019 under Sections 420 and 120-B of Indian Penal Code at Police Station City Kharar, District SAS Nagar, Mohali stands registered against the petitioner.

In view of the above, present petition is rendered infructuous.
