ANIL KSHETARPAL, J. (ORAL)

By this common order, two petitions bearing CRM-M-25833-
2017 and CRM-M-10519-2019 shall stand disposed of.

In both the petitions filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C., seeking quashing

of FIR No.67 dated 01.04.2016 registered under Sections 409 and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code at Police Station Radaur, District Yamuna Nagar, alongwith all the consequential proceedings arising therefrom has been sought.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from HC Ram Kumar, has submitted that the prosecution has already got recorded deposition of 9 witnesses out of total 12 proposed to be examined.

Keeping in view the fact that the criminal trial has already made substantial progress, this Court is not inclined to consider the prayer for quashing of the FIR alongwith all the consequential proceedings arising therefrom, at this stage. Hence, the present petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioners to raise all the defences as are permissible in law before the trial Court.

Learned trial Court is requested to make a sincere endeavour for disposal of the case expeditiously.
