Pursuant to the order of this court dated 05.09.2019, a status report by way of an affidavit of Sh. Jagmohan Singh, PPS, Deputy Commissioner of Police, Law & Order, Amritsar, has been filed in court today by the learned State counsel, a copy of which has been given to the learned counsel for the petitioners.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that in view of the fact that because one Bakhtawar Singh has been arrested as is stated in the aforesaid affidavit, presently he may be permitted to withdraw the petition, with liberty to file a similar one if he finds that proper action by the police is not being taken.

Dismissed as withdrawn, with it to be specifically stated by this court that no observation has been made as regards the guilt or innocence of

the accused, only a status report having been called for on the last date of hearing, with that status report filed and the petitioner satisfied with the stage of the investigation so far at least.
