The present petition has been filed under Section 439 Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.73 dated 14.11.2018, registered under Section 12 of the Protection of children from Sexual Offences Act, 2012 and Section 506 IPC, at Police Station Woman, Kurukshetra.

In compliance of order dated 04.04.2019, the status report has been received.

As per the status report, the statement of the prosecutrix has been recorded.

A bare perusal of the said statement transpires that the prosecutrix failed to support the prosecution version. Rather she has categorically stated that the petitioner was not involved in the wrong acts. Some unknown boys uttered wrong words to her.

The petitioner is in custody since 14.11.2018. The trial of the

case will take long time. No useful purpose will be served by keeping the petitioner in custody.

Without expressing any opinion on merits of the case and keeping in view the fact that conclusion of trial will take considerably long time, the present petition is allowed. Petitioner Hardeep alias Golu is ordered to be released on regular bail on furnishing bail bond and surety bond to the satisfaction of concerned trial Court/Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, subject to following terms:-

- (a) The petitioner shall comply with the conditions mentioned in Section 437(3) Cr.P.C.*
- (b) In the event of his absence on any date of hearing, the benefit of bail allowed to the petitioner shall stand withdrawn. The trial Court shall be competent to cancel his bail bond and surety bond and proceed to procure his presence in accordance with law. In that eventuality the petitioner shall have to apply for bail afresh.*
- (c) He shall not leave the country without the prior permission of the Court.*
