CRM-M No. 53242 of 2018 filed by the petitioner seeking direction to Senior Superintendent of Police, District Sri Muktsar Sahib and Station House Officer, Police Station Bariala, District Sri Muktsar Sahib. The said petition was disposed of on 03.12.2018 directing the Senior Superintendent of Police, Sri Muktsar Sahib to look into the matter pertaining to the allegations of murder of Surjan Singh and also causing of injuries to the petitioner and his mother. It was further directed that in case the allegations are found to be well founded then appropriate steps warranted under the law be taken.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the needful has not been done by the respondents.

Pursuant to notice of motion, learned State counsel filed a short reply dated 15.07.2019 by way of an affidavit of Mr. Manjit Singh Dhese, PPS, Senior Superintendent of Police, Sri Muktsar Sahib annexing the compliance report dated 13.05.2019.

Learned State counsel submits that the allegations have been looked into and the same have been found to be false.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the matter has not been properly enquired into and the compliance report is un-sustainable factually and legally.

The contention raised by learned counsel for the petitioner cannot be gone into the present petition. The direction was to look into the allegations and Senior Superintendent of Police, Sri Muktsar Sahib has already filed a compliance report.

Disposed of.

Rule issued against the respondents stands discharged.

Petitioner would be at liberty to avail remedy in accordance with law against the compliance report, if aggrieved.
