[1] Mr. Ram Avtar, Advocate has put in appearance on behalf of respondent No.3 – Insurance Company and has filed Vakalatnama in Court today. The same is taken on record.

[2] Despite the case having been called out twice, no one has put in appearance on behalf of the appellant. For that matter, even on 17.01.2019, no one was present on behalf of the appellant and the following order was passed on the said date:-

“Despite the case having been called out twice, no one has put in appearance on behalf of the appellant.

It appears that the appellant is not interested in pursuing the appeal.

However, in the interest of justice, adjourned to 24.01.2019.

Registry to inform the learned counsel for the appellant of the listing of the case in order to ensure representation on

the date fixed. In case of non-representation, it shall be presumed that the appellant is no longer interested in pursuing the appeal.”

[3] As per Registry note dated 23.01.2019, counsel for the appellant has been informed through e-mail, however, since none is present on behalf of the appellant, despite the case having been called out twice, it is apparent that the appellant is no longer interested in pursuing the appeal.
