Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.0095 dated 16.05.2018 under Sections 406, 498-A IPC, registered at Police Station City Kapurthala, District Kapurthala.

Vide order dated 26.07.2018, the petitioner was admitted on interim bail, subject to the conditions as envisaged in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. Thereafter, vide order dated 13.11.2018, parties were directed to appear before the Mediation Centre.

Pursuant to the aforesaid order, parties had appeared before the Mediator and the settlement/agreement dated 07.05.2019 has been reduced into writing.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has argued that pursuant to

the order dated 26.07.2018, petitioner has joined the investigation and the matter has been compromised between the parties.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Paramjit Singh, does not dispute the aforesaid fact and states that the recovery has been effected in the case.

Heard learned counsel for the parties.

Since the petitioner has joined the investigation and the matter has been compromised between the parties before the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court, the present petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 26.07.2018 is made absolute.

However, if required, the petitioner shall continue to join investigation as and when required to do so and shall abide by the terms and conditions, as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Since the matter has been compromised, the parties shall adhere to the terms & conditions of the settlement/agreement dated 07.05.2019 in letter and spirit.
