This petition has been filed under Section 482 of Criminal Procedure Code for issuance of directions to respondent Nos.1 to 4 to take legal action against respondent No.5.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of respondent No.5- Indusind Bank Ltd. does not dispute the outstanding amount to be paid by the petitioner i.e. Rs.1,15,000/- (over due at a particular stage) as noticed by this Court in order dated 20.07.2017. According to him, 50% of the amount already stands paid by him to the Bank. It is further stated by learned counsel for respondent No.5 that at present the petitioner is regularly paying him installments towards discharge of the liability of loan. It is further stated that since the installments are being paid regularly, there is no reason for

Bank to take the possession of the alleged vehicle much less forcibly.

In view of the stand of respondent No.5, nothing survives for adjudication in this petition and the same is rendered infructuous.
