Prayer in the instant writ petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India is for issuance of writ in the nature of Certiorari for setting aside the impugned order dated 14.03.2019 (Annexure P-11) and notice dated 19.02.2019 (Annexure P-8) passed by respondent No.2 and all other consequential proceedings arising therefrom.

2. Learned counsel for the respondents has produced a communication dated 25.04.2018 issued by respondent No.2 and submitted that during the pendency of writ petition on deposit of 20% of total outstanding demand for the assessment year 2011-12 i.e. ₹ 8,68,300/-, the interim stay has been granted till the disposal of the appeal, which is pending before the learned CIT(A)-2, Chandigarh. The said communication is taken on record.

3. In view of the above, learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the present petition has become infructuous and may be disposed of as such.
