On 27.03.2019, following order was passed by this Court:-

“In the instant petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C., prayer has been made for direction to respondents No.2 and 3, to protect the lives and liberty of the petitioners, at the hands of respondents No.4 to 6.

Notice of motion.

At the asking of the Court, Mr. A.S. Gill, DAG, Punjab has accepted notice on behalf of the respondent-State. Copy of the paper book be supplied to learned State counsel, during the course of the day.

List on 30.04.2019.

Meanwhile, respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Sangrur, is directed to look into the matter and find out the existence of alleged threat perception to the lives and liberty of the petitioners. Respondent No.2 shall also verify the antecedents of petitioners and residential address given by them and submit report on or before the date fixed.”

Learned counsel appearing for the State has submitted that the petitioners as well as respondents, 4, 5 and 6 have made a statement before the police to the effect that the petitioners have no threat to their life and

liberty. Respondents No.4, 5 and 6 have accepted the marriage of the petitioners and have no objection thereto.

The statements so recorded by the police have been placed on file which are taken on record.

In view of the aforesaid statement(s), the present petition is disposed of, as having been rendered infructuous. However, liberty is granted to the petitioners to file fresh petition, if they have any further apprehension.
