During the course of hearing, the contentions of learned counsel for the petitioner that the parties have settled their dispute and effected a compromise and have started living together, which is conceded to at bar by the counsel for the complainant and even the learned State counsel Mr. Saurav Khurana, DAG, Punjab on instructions from ASI Pushpinder Singh submits that the parties have resolved their dispute and he has no objection if the petitioner is allowed bail.

In the light of the statement made by the learned State

counsel, the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 02.07.2018 is made absolute till submission of report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. (challan). Thereafter, petitioner will be permitted to furnish regular bail bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court. The petitioner shall abide by the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

With these observations, the present petition stands disposed off.
