Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner, who is husband of complainant-Manpreet Kaur, in FIR No.24 dated 25.05.2018 under Sections 406, 498-A IPC, registered at Police Station Women, District Police Commissionerate, Amritsar.

Vide order dated 02.07.2018 passed by this Court, petitioner was admitted on interim bail. On September 04, 2018, learned State Counsel had submitted that household articles as well as bullet motorcycle given at the time of marriage have been recovered, but recovery of 10 tolas of gold is yet to be recovered in the case.

On 20.12.2018, counsel for the petitioner had sought time to

get instructions in respect of making fixed deposit in the name of the complainant of the alleged recovery of gold.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has argued that the petitioner is ready to deposit the value of 10 tolas of gold with the trial court within a week from today.

In view of the above, the order dated 02.07.2018 passed by this Court, whereby the petitioner was admitted on interim bail, is made absolute.

The petitioner shall deposit the FDR for a sum of Rs.3,50,000/- in the name of the complainant with the trial court within a week from today and the said amount would be released to the parties, subject to the outcome of the trial. In case complainant succeeds in the case, she would be entitled to get the FDR encashed.

In case, the petitioner fails to deposit the FDR within the stipulated period, the present petition shall be deemed to have been dismissed.

The present petition stands disposed of accordingly.
