Earlier, by filing CWP No.16227 of 2013, the petitioner had challenged the finding given by the Enquiry Officer dated 28.06.2011 (Annexure P-2), punishment order dated 07.09.2011 (Annexure P-3), order dated 21.05.2012 (Annexure P-5) and order dated 24.09.2012 (Annexure P-7). However, the said petition was withdrawn by the petitioner on 12.03.2015 (Annexure P-8) with liberty to file fresh amended petition.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that due to communication gap, the petitioner could not file fresh petition in time. Now, the present petition has been filed on 08.03.2019 i.e. after a gap of four years. The impugned orders were passed way back on 07.09.2011 (Annexure P-3). There is no plausible explanation for causing such a long delay in filing the present petition.

Accordingly, on the ground of delay itself, the present petition is dismissed.
