GURVINDER SINGH GILL, J. (Oral)

1. The present petition has been filed for quashing of FIR No.144, dated 15.5.2018, registered at Police Station Division A, Amritsar, under Sections 379-B, 323, 506, 148, 149 IPC and Section 25 of Arms Act, and proceedings emanating therefrom on the basis of a compromise having been effected between the parties.
2. Vide order dated 4.7.2018 the parties had been directed to appear before the trial Court so as to get the statements recorded.
3. Report of learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Amritsar, has been received wherein it has been reported that statement of complainant

Gurwinder Singh @ Raju as well as of petitioners/accused Jaskirat Singh @ Lala and Amarbir Singh @ Billa, have been recorded to the effect that they have entered into a compromise with the intervention of respectables. The complainant has specifically stated that the matter has been compromised and he does not want to pursue with the matter. Learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Amritsar, opined that the parties have entered into compromise out of their free will and without any coercion or undue influence and the compromise so entered into appears to be genuine.

4. In view of the aforesaid report and bearing in mind the law laid down by Full Bench of this Court in 2007(3) RCR (Crl.) 1052 Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab, the petition is allowed and FIR No.144, dated 15.5.2018, registered at Police Station Division A, Amritsar, under Sections 379-B, 323, 506, 148, 149 IPC and Section 25 of Arms Act, and all the consequent proceedings arising therefrom are hereby quashed qua the petitioners.
