Prayer made in this writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, is inter alia for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondent to grant six months' time to the petitioner to pay all the dues in their loan account and release the title deeds of the mortgaged properties on receipt of the dues.

2. After arguing for sometime, learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that he may be allowed to withdraw the present petition with liberty to the petitioner to approach the bank at the first instance or to avail the alternative remedies as are available to him, in accordance with law.

3. Dismissed as withdrawn. However, it shall be open to the petitioner to take recourse to the remedies as may be available to him, in accordance with law.
