Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C for issuance of directions to respondent Nos.2 and 3 for conducting fair and impartial enquiry/investigation in FIR No.0143 dated 18.07.2018 under Section 304 read with Section 34 of Indian Penal Code registered at Police Station Lambi, District Muktsar Sahib.

On 27.03.2019, learned State counsel was directed to find out the status of investigation in FIR No.0143 dated 18.07.2018.

Pursuant to this, status report by way of an affidavit of Iqbal Singh, PPS, Superintendent of Police, Sub Division Malout, District Sri Muktsar Sahib on behalf of respondent Nos.1 to 4 has been filed in the Court which is taken on record.

The relevant paragraph of the report is extracted below:-

“That accused Gurjant Singh @ Kala

son of Balkar Singh, resident of Lambi was arrested on 09.04.2019 by ASI Sukhwinder Singh of P.S.Lambi. Accused Manjeet Ram son of Sadhu Ram, resident of village Bhagu and Akash Kumar son of Roop Lal, r/o Gidderbaja were arrested on 18.04.2019 and accused Sukhpal Singh son of Narotam Singh, r/o Village Kaleran, District Sangrur was arrested on 21.04.2019. On completion the formal investigation, challna would be presented as early as possible.”

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner does not press this petition and prays for withdrawal of the petition.

Prayer is accepted.

Dismissed as withdrawn.
