Present petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. read with Section 12 of the Juvenile Justice (Care and Protection of Children) Act, 2015, for seeking regular bail to the petitioner, who was juvenile at the time of alleged occurrence, in case FIR No. 222, dated 01.10.2018, registered under Sections 323, 341, 307, 365, 34 IPC, at Police Station Nagina, District Nuh.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contended that the petitioner is in custody since 13.12.2018 and investigation is already complete in this case. Trial of the case still to take some more time and no useful purpose would be served by detaining the petitioner behind the bars, so he be released on bail.

Learned State counsel as well as learned counsel for the complainant opposed the application for bail on the ground that there were 11 injuries on the person of the injured. Learned State counsel fairly

conceded that weapon used for commission of offence was blunt and most of the injuries are abrasion and complain of pain.

Having considered the submissions made by learned counsel for the parties, at this stage, without commending anything on the merits of the case, which may not cause prejudice to either of the parties at a later stage, but taking the above facts into consideration and the fact the petitioner is in custody since 13.12.2018 and trial of the case still to take some more time, more so the petitioner was juvenile at the time of alleged occurrence, the present petition is allowed. Petitioner – Muneb, is ordered to be admitted to regular bail on his furnishing adequate bail bond and surety bond to the satisfaction of the concerned trial Judge/Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate.
