This is a petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No. 84 dated 14.5.2016 registered under Section 379-B (2) IPC, 1860 at P.S. Kamboj, District Amritsar.

Counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner was on regular bail and was regularly appearing before the Trial Court. He further states that the petitioner has never misused the concession of bail and only on one occasion he could not appear i.e. on 29.9.2018 because the father of the petitioner was in critical condition and was admitted in hospital. Further, the petitioner had also informed his counsel but the counsel could not move application and the Trial Court had issued non-bailable warrants against him.

In my opinion, in case above statement is correct, then one lapse can be condoned.

In the circumstances, let the petitioner appear before the Court on 3.4.2019 and if it is correct that he has never misused the concession of bail during the trial the Court would release him on bail to its satisfaction on that date.

The petition stands disposed of.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
