Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.182 dated 17.08.2018 under Sections 420, 465, 467, 468, 471 IPC, registered at Police Station City Faridkot, District Faridkot.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that as per allegations in the FIR, the complainant has introduced five other victims, from whom the amount was allegedly taken by the petitioner. It is further submitted that in fact none of the victims has come forward to support the allegations made in the FIR.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Sukhwinder Singh, has however submitted that the SIT was constituted and during the investigation conducted by the SIT, wife of the petitioner was found innocent and the victims have appeared and made a statement under Section 161 Cr.P.C.

Considering the fact that there are serious allegations against the petitioner that he has taken Rs.7.50 lacs from the victims on the pretext of providing them job in the Indian Army, I find no ground to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

Dismissed.
