Report dated 21.09.2018 of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate Bathinda has been received whereby after recording statements of petitioner Kamal Kant and complainant Ramanveer Kaur, the Court has shown its satisfaction that the compromise has been arrived at voluntarily, out of free will of the parties, without any undue influence, coercion or pressure.

Heard.

In the light of the satisfaction shown by the Court and the fact that the offences for which the accused has been hauled up are not of serious nature, together with the fact that

compromise will go a long way in ironing out differences for betterment of future life of the parties and in view of the law laid down in '**Gian Singh Vs. State of Punjab and another**' **2012 (4) RCR (Criminal) 543** and '**Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab and another**' **2007 (3) RCR (Criminal) 1052**, the prayer made in the petition is allowed, proceedings by way of FIR No. 95 dated 04.05.2018 registered at Police Station Civil Lines, Bathinda under Sections 354-A and 506 IPC, all consequences arising out of the said FIR qua the petitioner are quashed.

The petition stands allowed in those terms.
