Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is income tax payee but the amount in dispute has not been reflected in the income tax return. He further submits that the petitioner has joined investigation and the same has been affirmed by learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Hans Raj.

The allegations are matter of evidence, which shall be tested by the trial Court during trial and the case is based on documentary evidence. Moreover, civil suit filed by Ladhu Ram has already been dismissed.

Since the petitioner has joined investigation, interim order dated 10.08.2017 passed by this Court in favour of the petitioner is made absolute.

Petition is disposed of accordingly.

However, the petitioner is directed to join investigation, if required by the Investigating Officer.
