Petitioners have preferred this revision petition against the order dated 21.01.2019 passed by Additional District Judge, Palwal in execution whereby conditional warrants of arrest against the petitioners have been issued.

The execution was filed on 06.04.2016 and all efforts to secure presence of the petitioners/judgment debtors remained futile. Presence of the petitioners is sought to be secured by means of coercive method.

Only conditional warrants of arrest have been issued.

Learned counsel for the petitioners states that the petitioners are ready to settle the issue with the decree holder and even after issuance of warrants against them, they have paid some loan installments to the decree holder.

Be that as it may, there is no scope for interference in this revision petition.

If the petitioners are really interested in making good the payment in favour of the decree holder, they can approach the Executing court and settle the account by way of paying the dues to the satisfaction of the Executing Court.
