AVNEESH JHINGAN, J (ORAL)

The present contempt petition has been filed alleging wilful disobedience of the order dated 10.12.2018 passed by this Court in CWP No. 27158 of 2018.

The operational part of the order is reproduced below:-

“Petition is disposed of. In case petitioner sends a fresh copy of the legal notice/representation to the concerned authority alongwith a copy of this order by registered/speed post, the authority shall pass a speaking order at the earliest, in any case not later than six weeks of receipt thereof. If any amount is found due to the petitioner, payment of same be released after sanction from the Finance Department, if required.”

Learned counsel for respondents No.1, 2 and 4 states that the order of this Court has been complied with and the amount found due to the petitioner shall be released within two weeks from today.

In view of above, no cause of action survives in the present contempt petition.

Disposed of as infructuous.

However, if there is any discrepancy found in the statement made, petitioner would be at liberty to revive the present petition.
