Prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No. 209, dated 22.12.2018, registered under Section 61 of Punjab Excise Act, 1914 at Police Station City 1 Abohar, Tehsil Abohar, District Fazilka.

The learned counsel for petitioner states that petitioner has been falsely implicated in the case on account of certain business dealings with complainant.

Vide order dated 24.05.2019, this Court, while granting the concession of interim anticipatory bail, directed the petitioner to join the investigation.

The learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Sukhwinder Singh, states that the petitioner has joined the investigation.

In view of the above, petition is allowed. The order dated 24.05.2019, granting interim anticipatory bail to the petitioner, is made absolute. However, the petitioner shall join investigation as and when called upon to do so by the Investigating Agency and shall abide by conditions of Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
