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**GURVINDER SINGH GILL, J.(Oral)**

The petitioners have approached this Court seeking quashing of FIR No.223 dated 31.8.2012 registered at Police Station Rajpura City under Sections 406, 420 and 120-B of Indian Penal Code, 1860 including charge sheet framed under Sections 406, 420, 467, 468 and 471 of IPC and all subsequent proceedings emanating therefrom on the basis of a compromise having been effected between the parties.

Vide order dated 29.3.2019, the parties had been directed to appear before the Illaqa Magistrate/trial Court so as to get their statements recorded qua the factum of compromise.

Report of learned Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Rajpura has been received, wherein it has been reported that statements of petitioners/accused Thakur Dass, Surjit Ram, Raj Kumar, Sukhwinder Lal, Krishana Bai, Umesh Pandey, Chander Shekhar and Arvinder Pal Singh Bedi and also of complainant Hari Ram have been recorded to the effect that they have compromised the matter amongst themselves and they have no objection in case the FIR is quashed.

The learned Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Rajpura has specifically opined that the parties have entered into compromise voluntarily without there being any pressure, coercion or undue influence.

In view of the aforesaid compromise and bearing in mind the law laid down by Full Bench of this Court in 2007(3) RCR (CrL.) 1052 Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab, the present petition is allowed and FIR No.223 dated 31.8.2012 registered at Police Station Rajpura City under Sections 406, 420 and 120-B of Indian Penal Code, 1860 including charge sheet framed under Sections 406, 420, 467, 468 and 471 of IPC and all subsequent proceedings emanating therefrom are hereby quashed qua petitioners.
