This petition has been filed for issuance of directions under Section 482 of Criminal Procedure Code on the ground that the representation dated 19.03.2019 (Annexure P-2) is not being looked into by the Commissioner of Police, District Ludhiana-respondent No.2.

It is conceded that the father of the petitioner already stands arrested in case FIR No.54 dated 02.03.2019 under Sections 406, 420, 465, 468, 471 and 120-B of Indian Penal Code registered at Police Station Salem Tabri, District Ludhiana.

A perusal of the representation reveals that the petitioner has requested the Police authorities about the innocence of his father, sister and her husband. It is also conceded by learned counsel that sister of the petitioner is at large.

Since the FIR has been registered on 02.03.2019 and on legitimate grounds, father of the petitioner stands arrested, the representation

filed by the petitioner is totally misconceived and misplaced, therefore, no ground is made out for issuance of directions.

Petition is dismissed.
