This petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.84 dated 23.5.2016 registered under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471, 120B IPC, 1860 at police station City Sri Muktsar Sahib.

The allegations against the petitioner are that petitioner alongwith his co-accused had cheated the complainant and few other persons on the pretext of getting them jobs.

Counsel for the petitioner has argued that nothing has been recovered from the petitioner and no purpose would be served by keeping the petitioner further behind bars. He further states that the petitioner has been in custody since 18.11.2017.

Learned Deputy Advocate General on instructions from SI Krishan Kumar has accepted these factual assertions.

Without commenting on the merits of the case, keeping in view the above facts and the period of incarceration already suffered by the petitioner, I deem it appropriate to grant regular bail to the petitioner. Ordered accordingly, Bail to the satisfaction of the concerned Trial Court/Duty Magistrate.

Petition stands allowed.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
