The petitioner was allegedly implicated in a criminal case by the private respondents and he was ultimately acquitted. On being asked whether the false implication in a criminal case is a cognizable offence, the petitioner has failed to give any satisfactory answer. The petition is misconceived and is dismissed. However, the petitioner shall be at liberty to avail any other appropriate remedy available under the law.
