Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for issuance of directions to the official respondents No.2 and 3 to conduct a fair and impartial investigation in FIR No.21 dated 19.01.2019 under Sections 363 and 366-A read with Section 34 IPC registered at Police Station Lopoke, District Amritsar and to submit a final report in the case.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has argued that despite there being a representation (Annexure P-2) submitted by the petitioner on 27.02.2019 to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Amritsar (Rural), investigation in the case has not been conducted by the police and whereabouts of the daughter of the petitioner are not known to the petitioner.

Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 3 only at this stage.

On asking of this Court, Mr. Rana Harjasdeep Singh, Deputy Advocate General, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of official respondents No.1 to 3.

Let requisite number of copies of paper book be given to learned State counsel during the course of the day.

Without observing anything on the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to look into the contents of representation dated 27.02.2019 (Annexure P-2) and to act in accordance with law.
