GURVINDER SINGH GILL, J. (ORAL)

1. The petitioner has approached this Court seeking issuance of a direction to respondent No.2 to 5 to provide police help so as to enable him to harvest his crops.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner is in exclusive possession of land measuring 48 'Kanals' 18 'Marlas' but respondent No.6 to 8 have always been trying to dispossess him and that the plaintiff was constrained to file a civil suit against wife of respondents No.6 (arrayed as respondent No.7 in the present petition) and wife of respondent No.8, as the said defendants were staking claim to the land in question having purchased a part of joint holding from other co-shares. It has been submitted that although the suit was dismissed by the learned Additional Civil Judge (Senior Division), Charkhi Dadri but upon an appeal having been filed by the petitioner, the judgment passed

by learned Additional Civil Judge (Senior Division), Charkhi Dadri was set aside and suit was decreed vide judgment and decree dated 26.10.2018 (Annexure P-2). It has further been submitted that despite the matter having been decided by the Civil Courts, respondent No.6 to 8 are still trying to cause interference in the possession of the petitioner over the property in question and he apprehends threat at the time when he would be harvesting his crops.

3. Having heard learned counsel for the petitioner, the petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.4-Superintendent of Police, Charkhi Dadri to look into the representation (Annexure P-4) and to dispose of the same expeditiously and also to ensure that peace is maintained. However, it would be open to the petitioner to seek appropriate directions by way of filing appropriate application in the RSA which is stated to be pending and has not been admitted so far.
4. A copy of this order along with copy of representation (Annexure P-4) along with copy of judgment (Annexure P-2) be sent to respondent No.4-Superintendent of Police, Charkhi Dadri so as to enable him to do the needful expeditiously.
