JASWANT SINGH, J.(ORAL)

Petitioner is a resident of village Harpalpur, Block Ganaur, District Patiala. By filing the present petition he is seeking a direction to the officials concerned for retrieving the possession of around 7 Biswas of land comprised in Khasra No. 957, 2 Biswas comprised in Khasra No.961 and 8 Bighas and 3 Biswas comprised in Khasra No.951 recorded in the ownership of Nagar Panchayat and found to be in unauthorised occupation of Gursewak Singh, Gurmeet Singh, Dalip Singh and 15 other named villagers in compliance of the orders (three) dated 11.06.2018 (P-3 Colly) passed by the Collector, Patiala on the three applications instituted by the Gram Panchayat

under Section 7 of The Punjab Village Common Lands (Regulation)

Act 1961.

It is asserted that the Adjudicating Authority based upon the Revenue entries and the demarcation report Ex.P-4 has held the said residents to be in unauthorised occupation.

Upon directions, Ms. Anu Pal, Deputy Advocate General, Punjab on instructions from Mr. Surinder Singh Dhillon, DDPO, Patiala states that the three different appeals before the Commissioner under Section 7(2) of the 1961 Act stands filed by said persons and further action shall be taken on accordance with law, if need be by conducting a fresh demarcation.

In view of the stand of the State, learned Counsel for the petitioner states that no further directions are required.

Disposed of as infructuous.
