It is not in dispute that an appeal/revision of the petitioners is still pending. We would, therefore, not entertain the present petition, particularly, when on an earlier occasion, this Court had passed an order upon an undertaking given by the counsel for the State and if the same has been violated, the petitioners would have remedy against it and in any case as far as their principal grievance is concerned that issue has yet to be agitated before the Appellate/Revisional authority.

Hence, instant petition is disposed of with a liberty to the petitioners to pursue their remedies in law.
