The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.0127 dated 06.06.2018 (Annexure P-1) under Sections 419, 420, 120-B of Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Tripri Patiala, District Patiala.

Allegations against the petitioner-Ajaypal Singh are that in a transfer deed executed by his father-Rakam Singh, in favour of his brother-Rupinder Singh, he appeared before the Sub Registrar and signed as Rupinder Singh. From the FIR, it is made out that the said land measuring 1500 square yard was sold to the complainant by Rakam Singh-father of the petitioner on 17.10.2013 by taking full and final payment. Out of the same,

part of the land was transferred in favour of Rupinder Singh. Since it is a case of impersonation and forgery before the Sub Registrar, who is a public servant, as such, it is not a case of undue hardship. Hence, there is no ground to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

Accordingly, the petition is dismissed.
