This is a petition for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner under Section 438 Cr.P.C. in case FIR No.68 dated 01.02.2018 registered under Sections 406/419/420/465/467/468/471/120-B IPC at Police Station Sector 31, Faridabad.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that similarly situated co-accused Ram Singh was granted anticipatory bail vide order passed in ***CRM-M-54068 of 2018*** dated 21.01.2019.

Learned State counsel on instructions from SI Suresh Kumar has accepted that the role of the petitioner and Ram Singh was similar and that has been released on anticipatory bail.

In the circumstances, I see no reason to take a different view for the petitioner and consequently, grant him the concession of anticipatory bail in the same terms as in the above mentioned case.

Petition stands allowed.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
