A perusal of order dated 18.3.2019 does not clearly reflect that the learned Sessions Judge, Yamuna Nagar has directed the petitioner to deposit an amount of 20% and the import of the order is that the petitioner himself requested for an adjournment for deposit of the amount of 20%.

In view of the aforesaid position, this Court does not find any ground for passing any order, at this stage. The petition, as such, is dismissed with liberty to the petitioner to approach this Court again in case any such direction is specifically issued by the Court of Sessions.
