Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for quashing the impugned order dated 30.01.2017 (Annexure P-5), whereby the petitioners were declared as proclaimed persons in FIR No.3 dated 02.02.2012 under Section 498-A IPC, registered at Police Station Women Cell, Amritsar City, District Amritsar.

Learned counsel for the petitioners states that in the aforesaid FIR, police has conducted the investigation and challan was not presented against the petitioners. He further states that challan was presented only against the husband of the complainant, who has been acquitted in the case. The petitioners could not come to know about the proceedings initiated against them on the basis of application filed under Section 319 Cr.P.C. However, they are still ready to appear before the trial Court and to face the trial in accordance with law.

Notice of motion.

At the asking of the Court, Mr. Rana Harjasdeep Singh, D.A.G., Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State.

Learned counsel for the petitioners is directed to supply a copy of paper-book to learned State counsel during the course of the day.

Heard learned counsel for the parties.

Considering the limited prayer that the petitioners are ready to surrender before the trial Court to face the trial in accordance with law, the present petition stands disposed of.

In case, the petitioners appear before the trial Court within two weeks from today with an undertaking that during the proceedings, they will appear personally or through their representing counsel before the trial Court regularly, they shall be admitted on bail, subject to furnishing of their bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court.
