Present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of directions to official respondents to take necessary action for arrest of respondents No. 4 to 11-accused, in FIR No. 49 dated 08.11.2016, under Sections 302 and 149 of Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Amir Khas, District Ferozepur, Punjab.

In response to the notice of motion issued by this Court, short affidavit of Sh. Amarjit Singh, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub Division, Jalalabad, District Fazilka on behalf of respondents No. 1 to 3/State has filed in the Court today. The same is taken on record.

Perusal of the affidavit reveals that after investigation in the matter, cancellation report was prepared on 06.02.2018 and the same has already been presented before learned Illaqa Magistrate and

even the protest petition against the cancellation report has already been filed by the complainant.

On instructions from ASI Sukhdev Singh, learned State counsel has pointed out that the matter is pending for consideration on 29.07.2019.

In view of the above, no further directions are required to be issued in the matter and the same is disposed off.

However, it is clarified that the observations made by this Court may not be construed as an expression of opinion on the merits of the case by the Court concerned while taking into consideration the cancellation report.

It is also made clear that the petitioner would be at liberty to pursue protest petition, if so advised and the same shall be considered in accordance with law.
