AVNEESH JHINGAN, J (Oral):

After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner states that though the order has been passed in compliance of order of this Court but the Subsidy is not being disbursed by the respondent as per Seniority List.

The relevant portion of order dated 13.01.2017 is reproduced below:-

"This petition is disposed of at this stage with a direction that respondent No.2 i.e. Director of Industries and Commerce would consider the claim of the petitioner by passing a speaking order taking into consideration all the pleas taken up in representation annexure P-4. In case any representation is not traceable in the office, annexure P-4 appended with the petition may be considered as representation. It is directed that the said representation will

be decided within a period of three months after the receipt of certified copy of the order, by the above said authority, by passing a speaking order.”

As per order, only direction was given to the respondent for passing speaking order and needful has been done. Any violation in the Seniority List would give rise to a fresh cause of action.

The present contempt petition is dismissed with liberty to the petitioner to avail remedies as are available in accordance with law.
