Pleadings on record would indicate that the petitioner while serving as Manager-cum-Pharmacist in the Medical Store at Guru Gobind Singh College and Hospital, Faridkot being run under the aegis of the Indian Red Cross Society, District Branch Faridkot submitted a letter dated 21.02.2019 (Annexure P-5) offering to resign from his job.

Instant writ petition was filed seeking a mandamus to the respondent/authorities that his resignation be not accepted.

The precise case projected on behalf of the petitioner was that a resignation once tendered can always be withdrawn prior to acceptance of the same.

Mr. Aakash Singla, Advocate for respondents No.2 and 3 upon instructions from Mr. Subhash Chander, Secretary, District Red Cross Society makes a statement that the request offering to resign made by the petitioner has already been dealt with and rejected vide order dated 27.04.2019.

In view of the above, nothing survives for adjudication in the instant writ petition and the same is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.
