The present petition has been filed pleading wilful disobedience of the order dated 24.09.2018 passed in CWP No. 24319 of 2018.

Learned counsel for the respondent has filed a short affidavit of Mr. Deepak, Estate Officer, HSVP, Rewari, same is taken on record, copy handed over to the counsel for the petitioner. Along-with the affidavit, order dated 30.04.2019 has been annexed whereby, the petitioner was found entitled to refund of ₹88,886/- (earnest money + interest) and the said amount has already been paid.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in view of affidavit filed today, no cause of action survives for pursuing the present petition. However, he seeks liberty to avail remedy in accordance with law, if aggrieved of the calculation of interest.

Disposed of as infructuous, with liberty as prayed for.

Rule issued against the respondent stands discharged.
