Petitioner was ordered to be released on furlough to the satisfaction of the Sub Divisional Magistrate, Narela, New Delhi on furnishing two sureties in the sum of Rs.2,00,000/- for faithfully observance of the conditions specified in the release warrant, vide order dated 27.8.2018 passed by Commissioner, Gurugram Division, Gurugam.

Now, Sub Divisional Magistrate, Narela, New Delhi vide letter dated 8.10.2018 (Annexure P2) asked for demand draft along with the personal bonds in the sum of Rs.two lakhs.

Learned State counsel states that the condition imposed by the Sub Divisional Magistrate, Narela, New Delhi to submit demand draft may be removed.

As such, letter dated 8.10.2018 (Annexure P2) stands quashed

and the petitioner is ordered to be released on furlough on furnishing two sureties in the sum of Rs.two lakhs as ordered by the Commissioner, Gurugram Division, Gurugram.

Petition is accordingly allowed.
