These petitions under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973, have been filed for quashing of Complaints No. RBT-497 dated 15.06.2004 titled as “***Dilbagh Singh Cheema vs. M/s. Amrohi Barkh Merchants and another***” and RBT-877 dated 15.06.2004 titled as “***Dilbagh Singh Cheema vs. Sohan Lal***” under Section 138 of the Negotiable Instruments Act, 1881 and orders dated 02.09.2009 (Annexure P-3 in Crl. Misc. No. M-27773 of 2016) and 27.08.2008 (Annexure P-3 in Crl. Misc. No. M-26563 of 2016) whereby they have been declared as proclaimed offender.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the latter has compromised the matter with the respondent – Dilbagh Singh Cheema and the

above complaints under Section 138 of the Negotiable Instruments Act, 1881 have already been dismissed as withdrawn on the basis of compromise and necessary intimation was also sent to the SHO of the Police Station concerned to delete name of the petitioners from the Register of the proclaimed persons. Certified copies of orders passed in that regard by the trial Magistrate concerned have been filed in the Court, which are taken on record.

In view of the above, the instants petitions have been rendered infructuous and are disposed of as such.
