This petition has been filed for quashing of FIR No.40 dated 24.04.2018 registered under Sections 304-A, 279, 427 IPC at Police Station Bakhshiwala, Patiala and all consequential proceedings arising therefrom.

Reply filed by way of affidavit of Dalbir Singh Grewal, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police City-II, Patiala on behalf of the respondent is taken on record. Copy has been supplied. In the reply it has been mentioned that on investigation of the case it has been found that the accident took place due to the fault of the deceased and a cancellation report dated 25.06.2018 has been prepared.

Counsel for the petitioner states that in normal circumstances the fact that the cancellation report has been prepared would render the petition infructuous but in the present case the police have been sitting on the cancellation report for the past almost one year.

Learned Deputy Advocate General states that the cancellation report shall be filed within two weeks.

In this view of the matter, this matter has been rendered infructuous and the petition is dismissed as such.

Since the main case has been dismissed as having been rendered infructuous, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
