MAHESH GROVER, J.(O)

We notice from the prayer made in the petition that the petitioner seeks a SC certificate for Chandigarh, which is the requirement of the prospectus to enable the petitioner to admission to the post-graduate medical course.

No mandamus can be issued unless a demand has been raised and we find that the petition is silent in this regard. Except for making averments, no representation has been placed on record to indicate that the petitioner ever approached the respondents for the requisite certificate.

This would have ordinarily invited a rejection of the petition but noticing that the petitioner is aspiring to a post-graduate medical course, we would permit her to make a representation to the competent authority with a prayer for issuance of a SC certificate within a period of three days from today. If such a request is made, the competent authority shall decide the matter expeditiously noticing the constraint of time in the admission process. The decision shall in any case be taken within one week from the

date of submission of the request.

Petition stands disposed of.
