Present petition under Section 407 of the Code of Criminal Procedure has been filed for transfer of Criminal Complaint No.Coma-73-17 dated 13.02.2017 titled as 'Shalini versus Sukhwinder Singh' from the Court of learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Amritsar, to any other Court of competent jurisdiction at Jalandhar.

Learned counsel representing the petitioner contended that the petitioner, who is aged about 70 years, has to travel to Amritsar from Jalandhar and she is suffering from ailment.

This Court has considered both the grounds taken in the present petition. As far as distance from Jalandhar to Amritsar is concerned, it is not so significant that a person cannot travel on certain dates from the Court.

Secondly, as regard to medical plea taken by the petitioner, as per document Annexure-P2 (Case-Sheet) available on the file, there is no such ailment, which disentitle the petitioner to appear before the Court on certain dates. As such, no case is made out for transfer of the case from Amritsar to Jalandhar and the present petition is dismissed.
